- 50m Backstroke a time of 35.56 seconds, she beat the 2004 record of 37.00 seconds.
- 50m Breastroke a time of 38.95 seconds, she beat the 2008 record of 40.75 seconds.
- 200m Individual Medley 2.50.37. She beat the 2008 record of 2.54.80 seconds.

Congratulations also to Hayden Whyte who broke the 14 Years boys 50m Backstroke swimming a time of 32.66 seconds, he beat the 2008 record of 33.69 seconds.
